

Results of SRA Diversity Survey 2023

Solicitor's firms are now required to carry out an annual diversity survey for their firm. Responses must be submitted to the Solicitors Regulation Authority and made accessible to the public. Completion by non-fee earning staff is not compulsory and the data regarding religion and sexual orientation is excluded from the publication requirement. Publication of the data has to take a form of which individuals cannot be identified.
